

ORDINANCE 15-008

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PIKEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA,
AMENDING SECTION 52.04 OF THE TOWN OF PIKEVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES,
ASSOCIATED WITH RESIDENTIAL AND BUSINESS ELECTRIC RATES;
PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Pikeville, North Carolina, directed the Town Administrator to make certain amendments to the Town's electric rates, which included the residential and business electric rates; and

WHEREAS, making certain amendments to the Town's electric rates, necessitates amending Section 52.04 of the Town of Pikeville Code of Ordinances, associated with residential and business electric rates.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Pikeville, North Carolina, as follows:

Section 1. Section 52.04 (**ELECTRIC RATE**) of the Town of Pikeville Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 52.04 ELECTRIC RATE.

(A) Residential Flat Rate and Other Monthly Use Charge.

The monthly residential flat rate, and the other monthly residential use charge, shall be as set forth in the Town's Fiscal Year Budget, as amended and/or noted annually.

(B) Business Flat Rate and Other Monthly Use Charge.

The monthly business flat rate, and the other monthly business use charge, shall be as set forth in the Town's Fiscal Year Budget, as amended and/or noted annually.

(C) Temporary Service Connection Fee.

(1) Twenty-five dollars, non-refundable.

(2) After ten working days, full electric deposit, and flat rate monthly charges. Meters are read at cut-on, and cut-off for billing purposes.

Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, provision, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, provision, or portion shall be deemed a separate distinct, and independent provision of such holding, and shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases, provisions or portions thereof.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
